By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

On March 16, 2018, Applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 87308827, with Opposer's consent, and Opposer's withdrawal of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment, Applicant seeks to amend the identification of goods in International Classes 9 and 12 as follows (additions shown in bold).

International Class 9

from

proximity sensor for opening a vehicle's tail gate

to

proximity sensor for opening a vehicle's tail gate, **not for use as an autonomous vehicle**

International Class 12

from

aftermarket automobile accessories, namely, an automated tail gate opener; auto accessories, namely, an automated tail gate opener; land vehicle parts, namely, an automated tail gate opener; vehicle parts, namely, an automated tail gate opener; automobile tail gate opener

to

aftermarket automobile accessories, namely, an automated tail gate opener; auto accessories, namely, an automated tail gate opener; land vehicle parts, namely, an automated tail gate opener; vehicle parts, namely, an automated tail gate opener; automobile tail gate opener, **all the foregoing not for use an autonomous vehicle**

The amendment is limiting in nature, as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a). Because Opposer consents thereto, the amendment is approved and entered. *See* Trademark Rule 2.133(a). The contingency in Opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed in accordance with the agreement between the parties.
