After initial, productive settlement discussions between the parties, Opposer's counsel presented Applicant with a draft Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") on January 18, 2019. Thereafter, on July 14, 2019, after consultation with the client, Applicant's counsel provided Opposer's counsel with a mark-up of the Agreement. On October 7, 2019, Applicant's counsel contacted Opposer's counsel to inquire as to the status of the review of the Agreement. They were advised that the main contact in charge of this matter was on leave and that the new individual in charge had just returned from leave and was reviewing the latest draft. On October 30, 2019, Opposer's counsel forwarded a near final version of the Agreement to Applicant's counsel for review. On December 30, 2019, Applicant's counsel forwarded a response to Opposer's counsel. Thereafter, on January 10, 2020, counsel for both parties further discussed the Agreement. In June 2020, counsel for the parties again discussed the Agreement and sought their respective clients' instructions. Status inquiries in August 2020, September 2020, October 2020, November 2020, January 2021, March 2021, May 2021, July 2021, September 2021, and November 2021, revealed the parties were still in the process of considering final proposals. In March 2022 and April 2022, the parties were close to finalizing the Agreement. In August 2022, following exchanges in June 2022, Opposer's counsel indicated that the final version of the Agreement was to be circulated shortly. However, busy schedules have delayed movement on the execution version of the Agreement until recently in February 2023 when counsel for both parties discussed final points and execution logistics. Execution of the Agreement is expected within the requested 30-day extension period.

The parties are located in different parts of the world. The time difference coupled with client availability, counsel availability and other scheduling/availability obstacles compounded by the Covid-19 pandemic have delayed matters on both sides.

Applicant has secured Opposer's express consent to the extension and re-setting of dates requested herein.
