On August 30, 2023, Applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 97365379, with an allegation of Opposer's consent. By the proposed amendment, Applicant seeks to delete the services in International Class 38 in their entirety.

In an opposition to an application having multiple classes, if the applicant files a request to amend the application to delete an opposed class, the request for amendment is, in effect, an abandonment of the application with respect to that class, and is governed by Trademark Rule 2.135. *See* TBMP § 602.01 (2023). Trademark Rule 2.135 provides as follows:

After the commencement of an opposition, concurrent use, or interference proceeding, if the applicant files a written abandonment of the application or of the mark without the written consent of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against the applicant. The written consent of an adverse party may be signed

by the adverse party or by the adverse party's attorney or other authorized representative.

Inasmuch as Applicant has stated that the abandonment was with Opposer consent, the Board will allow Applicant an opportunity to submit Opposer's written consent. In view thereof, Applicant is allowed **TWENTY DAYS** from the date of this order in which to submit Opposer's written consent to the abandonment, failing which judgment will be entered against Applicant as to International Class 38, and the opposition will be sustained.
