Rule 41(a)(2) that:

1. Plaintiffs' Motions for Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause for a

Preliminary Injunction is dismissed with prejudice;

2. The Court dissolves its February 27, 2021 TRO [Dkt. 35];

3. This action is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, with each party to bear their own costs

and expenses including attorney's fees; and

4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purposes of enforcing the terms of the Parties'

settlement agreement.
