WHEREAS, on February 18, 2021, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, Plaintiffs filed Emergency Motions for Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause for a Preliminary Injunction [Dkt. 2].

**WHEREAS**, on February 27, 2021, the Court entered its Order granting Plaintiffs' Motions and issued a Temporary Restraining Order [Dkt. 35].

WHEREAS, the Parties have now reached a confidential settlement agreement under which

the Parties have agreed to the terms of this stipulation.

WHEREAS, the Parties stipulate that this action be DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

IT IS THEREFORE STIPULATED AND AGREED and HEREBY ORDERED under

**Rule 41(a)(2)** that:

1. Plaintiffs' Motions for Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause for a

Preliminary Injunction is dismissed with prejudice;

2. The Court dissolves its February 27, 2021 TRO [Dkt. 35];

3. This action is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, with each party to bear their own costs

and expenses including attorney's fees; and

4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purposes of enforcing the terms of the Parties'

settlement agreement.
