<b>Wed., January 26, 2022</b>	Transcript shall be ordered.
<b>Fri., February 25, 2022</b>	Transcript shall be filed by court reporter.
<b>Wed., April 6, 2022</b>	Appellant's opening brief and excerpts of record shall be served and filed pursuant to FRAP 31 and 9th Cir. R. 31-2.1.
<b>Fri., May 6, 2022</b>	Appellee's answering brief and excerpts of record shall be served and filed pursuant to FRAP 31 and 9th Cir. R. 31-2.1.

**The optional appellant's reply brief shall be filed and served within 21 days of service of the appellee's brief, pursuant to FRAP 31 and 9th Cir. R. 31-2.1.**

**Failure of the appellant to comply with the Time Schedule Order will result in automatic dismissal of the appeal. See 9th Cir. R. 42-1.**
