

Quick Start Guide

Find your Case

- Click into the **search bar**.
- From the **Filter** dropdown, select **Docket** and enter the docket number.

Optional: Add search criteria, e.g.,

[+ party](#) [+ judge](#) [+ keyword](#)

- Deselect Documents.

» By default, Docket Alarm searches both docket sheets, and the pleadings' underlying text.

Track a Case

- Click into a docket from the case results.
- Click **Track Docket** at the top of the case.
- Select the **frequency** of the alert.
- Use the **Alert Sharing** field to send to other users within your account.
- Group and organize alerts with the **Matter** field.

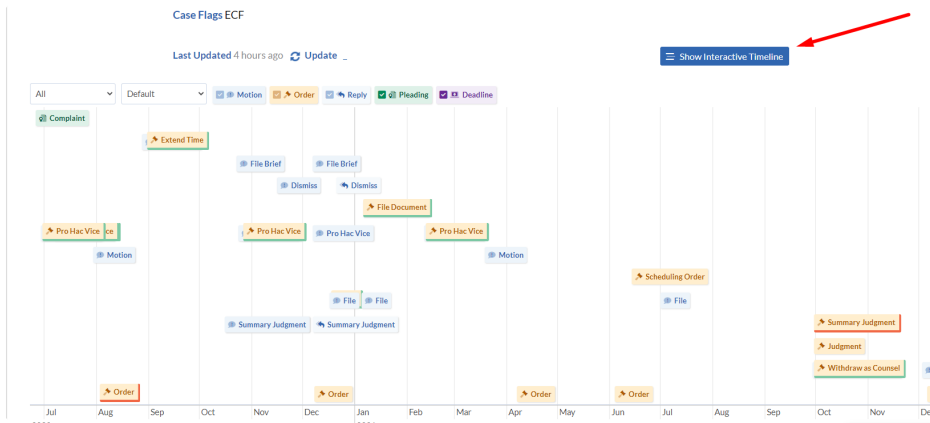

Integrate Your ECF

- Add your ECF credentials to convert these ECF alerts into shareable, user-friendly, realtime alerts, and also save on PACER fees.
- Click the ECF Integration Setup button on the Dashboard, then input your credentials.
- Alerts are setup automatically, and displayed in blue italics.

Bulk Download Case Documents

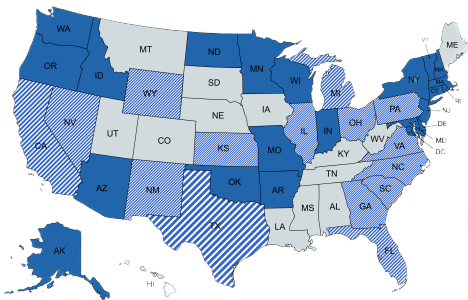
- Click **Download Docs** on the top of the case.
- Check the box for the documents to be downloaded.
- Click **Select All** to check all documents to be downloaded.
- Click **Download**.



Interactive Pleading + Motion Timeline

- Displays the tagged case events.
- To view the case timeline, click **Interactive Timeline**.
- To search similar pleadings and motions:
 - » Hover over the motion tag.
 - » Select search criteria.

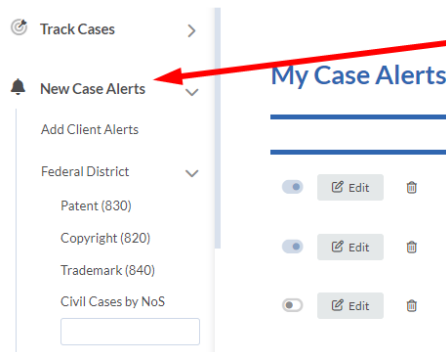

Supplemental Search

Use supplemental search when you cannot find a case using the standard Docket Alarm search. Supplemental search contacts the courts directly without relying on Docket Alarm having a copy of the case.

Federal Courts: Nationwide Find Federal cases across the country. Federal Courts: Direct Find recently filed Federal cases. State and Local Find cases in state and local courts.

Search

Set up Client Alerts

- On the **Dashboard**, click **New Case Alerts**.
- Click **Add Client Alerts**.
- Enter in Firm or Attorney information and click **Pull client list** and continue.
- To add alerts by Client Name, click **Skip Step**.
- Confirm and enter client names.
- Click **Add Client Alerts**.
- Select **Frequency** and click **Add**.

Search the Database

To narrow your search, use the *Query Builder* and *Filters*, further refine your search by judge, firm, case type, motion type, etc.

- **Option 1:** Click the *search bar* to open the *Query Builder* (see *Find Your Case* on page 1).
 - » To view all filters, click the *search bar* and click **Full Search Documentation**.
 - » Input desired information. To see more filter options, click **Filter By**.
- **Option 2:** Run your search, and on the *results page*, use the filters on the left side of the screen.
 - » To add a *filter*, click the term.
 - » To remove a filter, click the - (minus sign) to the left of the term.

Supplemental Search

- **Unable to find a case?** Use the *Supplemental Search* tool to query the court directly, pulling the case into Docket Alarm.
- From the search bar, click the *Courts* button.
- Then click **Supplemental Search**.

File Document Procedural: 1/6/2021

A docket entry's "Motion to File Document" (without more) could have several meanings (e.g., file documents under seal, file brief, file petition, file evidence).

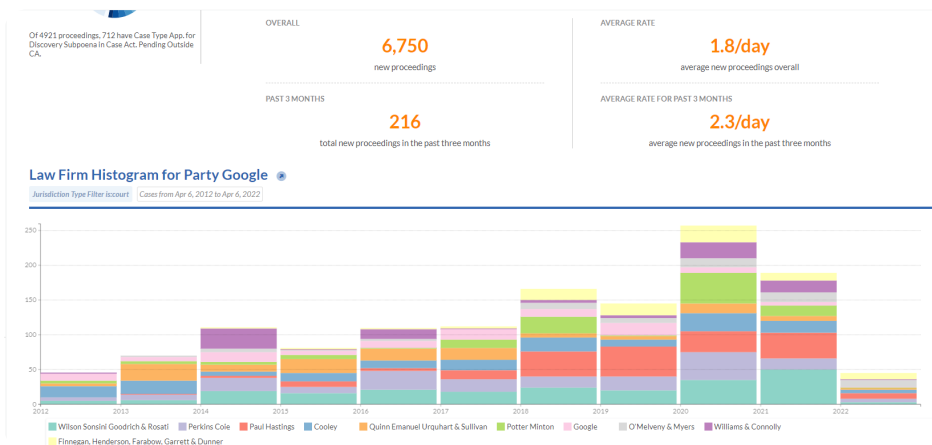

Federal Analytics

- Docket Alarm has tagged 220+ motion/order/pleading types to create Motion Tags. With these Motion Tags, you can analyze likelihood of winning motions — and how long it will probably take — before any particular court, judge, or case type.
- To access federal analytics from a docket, hover over any Pleading or Motion Tag.
- Click **Analytics**.
- To access federal analytics from the dashboard, on the left side, click **Analytics**.
- Click **Federal Analytics**.

Easy Analytics

- Run analytics on any party, judge, firm, or attorney across our entire database.
- Answer questions like (1) which firms are clients using? or (2) what case types does a judge or firm work with most?
- To access **Easy Analytics**, on the dashboard's left side, click **Analytics**.

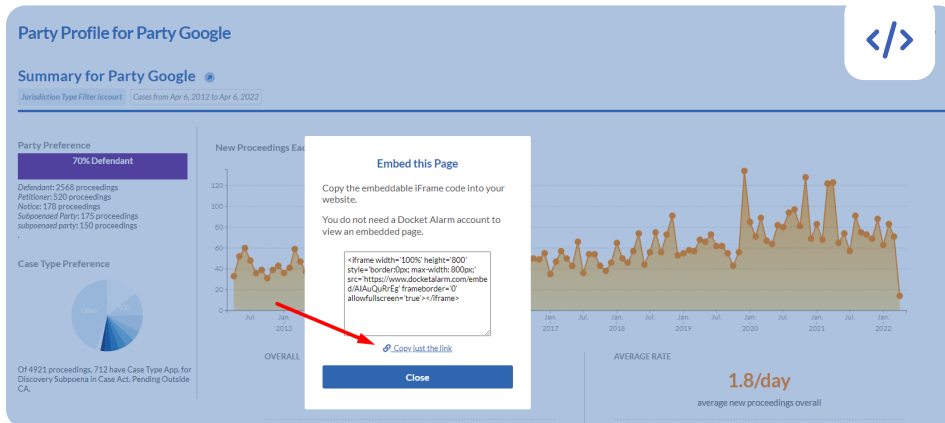

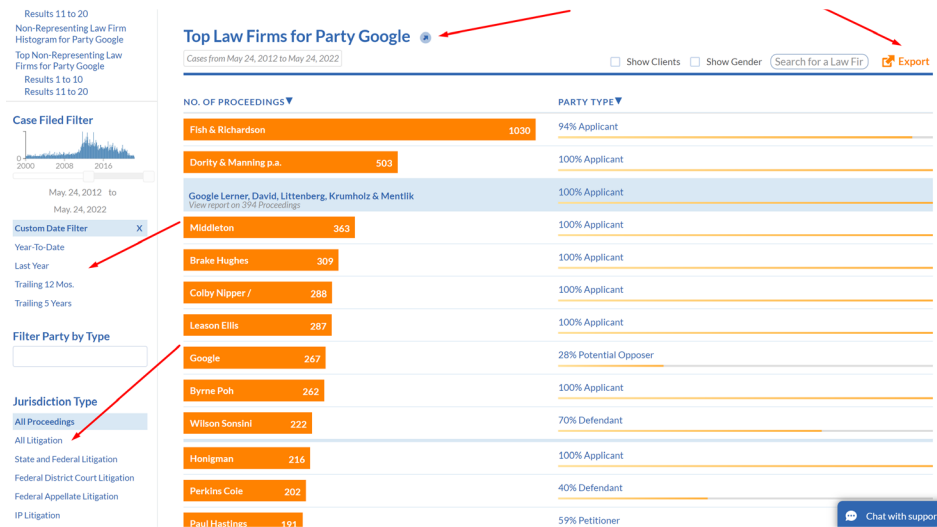

Share Analytics with Clients

- Share a live link to any of Docket Alarm's analytics with anyone, even if they aren't a Docket Alarm user, through our **Embed** feature.
- Whenever these links are opened, reports will re-generate with updated analytics.
- To create a link to share, on the report's upper-right corner, click the **Embed** icon.
- Click **Copy just this link**.
- To save as a PDF, on the report's upper-right corner, click the **PDF** icon.



Helpful Hints

- To access all analytics, on the Dashboard's left side, click the **Analytics** button.
- **FILTER:** On the left side of the analytics, filter by date, representation type, jurisdiction type, court and state.
- **LITIGATION ONLY:** To remove patent and trademark filings, under **Jurisdiction Type**, click the **All Litigation** filter.
- **ISOLATE SECTION:** To view a section of the report as its own report, to the right of the heading, click the **Arrow Icon**.
- **EXPORT:** To export a section of the report as Excel, click the **Export** button.
